## Drug & Alcohol Abuse Prevention Program Review

California Healing Arts College (“CHAC”) participates in Title IV Federal Student Aid programs and is required to review CHAC’s Drug & Alcohol Abuse Prevention Program at least once every two years in order to determine the program’s effectiveness and to ensure that program sanctions are being enforced.
